BLIGH have shied away from theatricality and their new single *Mrs Jones* demonstrates this perfectly. The song is an effective blend of macabre cinematic pop with blues rock, alternative and 80's synthpop that showcases how BLIGH can flippantly traverse their influences; from The Whitlams, to The Wombats, to Panic! At The Disco.

Musically, BLIGH is all about the build and Mrs Jones is no exception. From it's piano vocal intro to swing to pink panther bass lines the band is constantly adding new elements and subtle variations that make each section of the song as enthralling as the last. *Mrs Jones* is concluded with a rip roaring solo section that showcases the jazz and classical musicality of the bands keyboardist and guitarist, Zahra Whyte and Luc Saint Clair.

The song was written in response to Elliott, BLIGH's lead singer and songwriter, binge watching English crime shows like The Bill and Midsummer Murders. The end result is an unfurling narrative about a missing woman and her fate.

"Our goal was always to write one song, pop music operettas," says Elliott "To try and give the character or narrator, generally me, a fully fledged narrative that builds with the music; like a movie that only exists in my head."
